

- Inner Guard: Positioned at the inner door during Lodge meetings, the Inner Guard allows only those qualified to enter.
- **5-Year Trustee:** The Lodge Trustees control the funds and property of the Lodge and hold regular monthly meetings, keep a record of all investments and purchase all Lodge supplies, provide for an Accident Prevention Program, and present an annual Lodge budget.

Second Nominations and Elections are Thursday, February 27, 2025. Meetings start at 7:30 every second and fourth Thursdays of the month. This is an opportunity for you to have a say for who you would want your officers to be.




FANTASY FOOTBALL LEAGUE



ILINE PAYMENT SYSTEM

The Elks will be going to a new online payment system. Currently, we have Revopay and as of April 1, we will be working with the system Aliaswire. If you are presently using Revopay, there will be no interruption of payment services for you, and you should not have any problems using it. Aliaswire will be more efficient and a faster method for payment. Hopefully more members will want to use this online payment method as opposed to writing checks. As far as you needing to reapply, you don't need to worry. Your information will be transferred to this new system, and you shouldn't see any difference.




