





The Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks Convenes in Minneapolis MN, July 2-July 5th.

#### Red, White, and Blue Trifle

It's layered with cake, fresh berries, and fluffy whipped cream!

Recipe By Erin Merhar

Ingredients

8 oz. cream cheese, at room temperature

1/2 c. granulated sugar

1 1/2 c. heavy cream

1 tsp. vanilla extract

1 lb. pound cake, cubed.

2 6 oz. containers blueberries (about 2 cups)

2 6 oz. containers blackberries (about 2 1/2 cups)

1 1/2 qt. sliced strawberries, stems removed.

#### Directions:

Combine the cream cheese and granulated sugar in the bowl of a stand mixer with a paddle attachment. Beat on medium-high speed for 1 to 2 minutes until smooth. Scrape the sides and bottom of the bowl. With the mixer on medium, slowly add the heavy cream and vanilla and mix until combined. Switch to the whisk attachment and whip at medium speed until soft peaks form and the mixture is easy to dollop.

Place a single layer of cake cubes in a large trifle dish (about 12 to 14 cups). Top with 2/3 of the blueberries and blackberries, then 1/2 of the whipped cream (about 2 cups), then 2/3 of the strawberries. Repeat the cake and cream layers once more, then decorate the top with the remaining berries. Serve immediately or make in advance and store for up to 24 hours in the refrigerator.

#### **Trifle Variations**

- 1. Substitute pound cake with cubed angel food cake or just torn pieces of angel food cake
- 2. Add layers of vanilla instant pudding or banana pudding between layers instead or along with whipped cream.
- 3. Add in different fruit that you love between the layers of cake
- 4. Make jello cubes and layer them in for a change
- 5. Make it a chocolate on chocolate trifle and layer with whipped cream and a vanilla layer or choc chips
- 6. Always add in lots of fruit on the top to make it all beautiful
