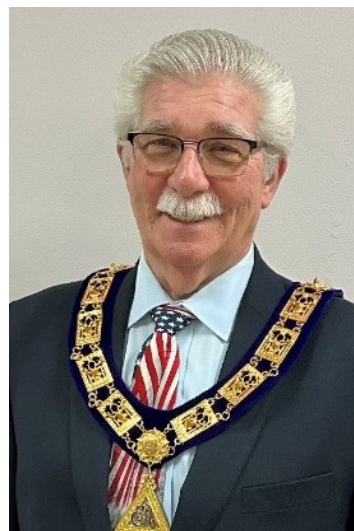

LADIES HIGHLIGHTS

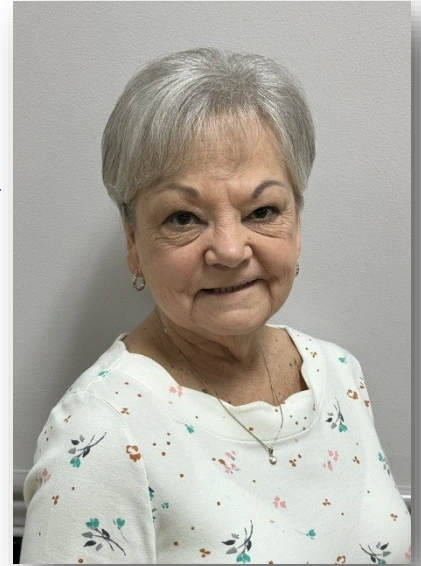
Nothing new is going on except this heat. Hope everyone is staying hydrated and cool.

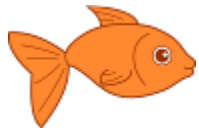
NEWPORT ELKS 273 HELPS FIGHT FOOD HUNGER

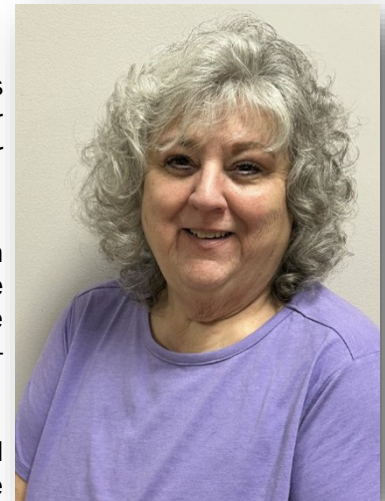
Donna Maltaner — Donna's sister passed away earlier this month. Please pray for Donna and her family.

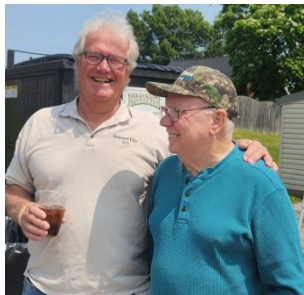
