

Nothing new is going on except this heat. Hope everyone is staying hydrated and cool.


All the by-law changes have been voted on and passed. We will have copies for members at the July meeting. Also, the meeting in July will be a tasters. Please bring a dish to share.

### EWPORT ELKS 273 HELPS


