This is a \$4 decrease from last year due to a decrease of \$4 for insurance to Grand Lodge.

Thank you to everyone who has donated to the Elks National Foundation. We have reached and exceeded the Grand Exalted Ruler's goal of \$5.00 per member. As of now, we are over \$8.00 per member!! For every \$1.00 we give, we receive \$1.90 in return for our veterans and youth programs. 






FANTASY FOOTBALL LEAGUE


Dan Webb—Dan is back to the lodge and playing cards. So glad to see you.


